This morning we travel to Tortuguero National Park where we will enjoy guided boat trips and wildlife viewing through the canals and coastal jungle. Enjoy a delicious Costa Rican breakfast en route as we transfer by road then boat through the famous canals of Tortuguero. This tropical eco-paradise is home to countless bird and animal species, and you will have many opportunities to view and photograph wildlife. The tropical rainforest gives way to prime secluded beaches, ideal nesting grounds for green turtles, loggerhead, hawksbill, and leatherback turtles.

After lunch at our beautiful eco lodge we will explore the park on a boat tour within Tortuguero National Park. Tortuguero Canal boat tour at the amazing Tortuguero National Park is an unforgettable experience that seems to transport you to an ancient time where crocodiles are the kings of the jungle.

The Sea Turtle Conservancy Tortuguero Visitor Center is an educational center located in the heart of Tortuguero National Park, one of the most important sea turtle nesting sites in the world for green turtles. STC has been working with green turtles in Tortuguero since 1959, making it the world's oldest sea turtle research and conservation group.

February 12 - Day 7



Monteverde

This morning we will explore the cloud forest on a guided hike. It's time to head into the cloud-covered forest, past oversized ferns and exotic orchids. Harness your inner Tarzan and Jane as you imagine swinging from the giant vines. Trudge along 12km (7 mi) of trails, watch for wildlife, and trek to the top of the observation tower. Be sure to stop and listen, too. Hear the haunting call of the bellbird and perhaps catch sight of the brilliant green and red resplendent quetzal.

This afternoon it is time for some adventure. Sky Trek zipline courses begin at the top of the mountains, you'll ride and open air gondola to this point while admiring the best views of the surrounding area and even more. From there on, you will start the zipline course down the mountain. Cables stretch from mountain to mountain, reaching incredible lengths and heights, crossing canyons, going into the forests, and even sometimes in between clouds. But Sky Trek is more than that, live a unique experience beyond distance or heights, admire unique views, and feel the adrenaline like no other adventure.
